The food can be used for community kitchens, prepared meals, emergency food relief and food pantries. Some of our charity partners use our food to teach valuable skills like leadership, responsibility and even how to cook.

One of our charity partners, The Salvation Army is able to provide a variety of services to their clients through Foodbank. They have a pantry full of affordable groceries, emergency food relief, and a community kitchen to serve people in need whilst also teaching essential cooking skills that can be valuable in their future.

### HOW IT WORKS



After applying for a free Foodbank membership and being approved, you will receive login details to our online ordering portal.



This portal will allow you to order food\*, which can be delivered for a small fee per pallet or alternatively, you can pick up your order from our warehouse in Glendenning.



Charities must be registered with the Australian Charities and Not-for-Profit Commission (ACNC), maintain relevant insurances and have the means to distribute food in their local area.



<sup>\*</sup>Currently all fruit, vegetables and bread are free of charge, whilst some other products attract a small handling fee.
